



SEEKING RESPIRATORY AND SLEEP CLINICIANS FOR MOTOR NEURONE DISEASE RESEARCH INTERVIEWS

Dr. Marnie Graco, Dr. Kate Carey and Professor David Berlowitz from the Institute for Breathing and Sleep and The University of Melbourne are conducting research to map the models of non-invasive ventilation and respiratory care for people living with Motor Neurone Disease (MND).

Research has shown that using non-invasive ventilation improves quality of life and can extend life for people with MND. However, the best information we have suggests that just **one in five** people with MND in Australia try non-invasive ventilation (NIV). Your input will be invaluable in understanding the current landscape of respiratory and sleep care for people with MND across Australia.
